- How many people? Please let us know how many adults and how many children you are with your ages
- First name, last name, date of birth, vaccination status (if known) of every person
- Please indicate any family groups or relationships
- If anyone is pregnant, you must let us know as well
- Have you got any pets with you? If so, which ones?
- Your mobile phone number and current whereabouts
- Let us know when you will need the accommodation

Getting from A to B?

You can use public transport buses and the urban railway operated by the Deutsche Bahn (DB) for free throughout the entire city.

Application for residence permit

Once you have been registered with the municipal administration, please contact our Immigration Office for a residence permit.

Note: You can initially stay in Germany for 90 days with no restrictions. During this time, you can move around freely within Germany and think about where you would like to stay in the long term. At the end of these 90 days, you must apply for a residence permit.

We will need the following information:

- Ukrainian identity document or Ukrainian residence permit
- Completed and signed application for benefits according to the AsylbLG (German law on asylum-seekers benefits)
- Passport photos of all family members over the age of 14 (please write the first and last name of the person shown on the rear of the photo)
- Completed and signed data protection declaration for the electronic health insurance card (eGK)
- Bank account and account holder (possibly of the persons providing you with accommodation too)
- Registration certificate, as soon as this has been issued

- Certificate for the extension of a residence permit (Fiktionsbescheinigung) / residence permit from the Immigration Office, as soon as this has been issued
- Completed and signed declaration on rent (for a privately rented apartment)
